## **RE: Strike Action Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March**

I'm writing to let you know that the strikes planned for Wednesday and Thursday of this week will be going ahead.

Just to remind you strikes are happening because of a national dispute between the unions and the government over teachers' pay and not because of any issues at our school.

As in previous strike days, we are expecting the same number of staff to be out of school, and are therefore having to close school to all year groups except Y11, Y12 and Y13 for exams.

**Year 11 will sit their remaining mock exams on Wednesday and Thursday.** Their timetable has already been shared with them. All Year 11 students are to attend school on both days.

**Year 12 and 13 will sit their exams as per their exam timetable already shared with them via tutor notices, TEAMS and the sixth form notice board.** Year 13 will be in both days, Year 12 just on Thursday.

All other year groups will remain at home doing home learning/revision using TEAMS.

## **School production rehearsals**

As the school production draws ever closer, our Head of Drama, Mr Pullen, has requested that members of the cast use the time on the strike days to continue with their rehearsal practice.

If your child is part of the cast, Mr Pullen will be sending out an invitation to come into school at various times on Wednesday or Thursday or both.

This is a great opportunity for the cast to spend time together working on the show.

At Moseley School and Sixth Form, we are committed to safeguarding and to promoting the welfare of our students.
