### Revision checklist for writing:

- Simple, compound and complex sentences and their uses/effects
- Different methods for varying sentence openings (e.g. starting with a simile, starting with a present participle, starting with an adverb, starting with a past participle, starting with an adjective)
- Language devices for non-fiction (e.g. direct address, anecdotes, facts, opinions, rhetorical questions, repetition, exaggeration, emotive language, statistics, rule of three)
- Different types of sentence structures (see Writing Skills knowledge organisers)
